













Satralizumab safety risks

The side effects associated with satralizumab use in MOGAD are being studied in the METEOROID study

The most common side effects related to satralizumab observed in people with NMOSD

Very common (occurs in more than 10% of patients)	Common (occurs in 1-10% of patients)
 Headache	 Muscle and joint stiffness
 Injection reactions (itching, rash)	 Rash or itching
 Diarrhea	 Difficulty sleeping or falling asleep
 Joint pain	 Migraine
 Decreased white blood cell count	 Swelling of hands, feet or lower leg
	 Hay fever
	 Decreased level of fibrinogen (a protein needed for blood clotting)
